- GSHS guidelines are to be followed in accordance with the completed and signed ICT Agreement (signed on enrolment).
- The device will only be used for educational purposes when connected to and using school services.
- It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that the private laptop is secured when not in use. GSHS takes no responsibility for theft, loss, vandalism, damage or unauthorised access to private laptops.
- BYO devices must contain a virus scanner with up to date data virus definitions.
- It is the responsibility of the student to back up data on the private laptop eg: to external hard drive, OneDrive or USB.
- Any software installed under Education Queensland agreements must be removed from the private laptop as per the conditions of the agreement such as if the student leaves GSHS. Any privately owned software installed on the laptop must be age appropriate, follow **copyright legislation** and not cause offence.
- GSHS and the Education Department reserve the right to restrict access and use of any private laptop used on the GSHS school campus, whether it is connected to the network or not. Access to the school network and permission to use the private laptop on school grounds will be withdrawn as a consequence of any inappropriate use and/or security breach. Cloud Based Services such as iCloud or Dropbox must not be used at school to store, send or access information at school.
- One Drive for Business is an Education Queensland approved cloud solution that students can use to store, send and access information both at school and at home.
- Terms and conditions are valid as long as student is enrolled at Goondiwindi State High School.
